SUBJECT: Request for Information of CAP Members Killed on Duty

1. The CAP National History Program is working to compile a comprehensive database of all CAP members who have died while in service to CAP since World War II. To oversee and direct this effort, I have selected Major Seth D. Hudson, Southwest Region Historian.
2. This database will include all members who were killed in accidents as well as those who died from medical reasons while on duty.
3. I ask each and every unit to, please, send us any information you have regarding any and all CAP members who have died while on CAP duty. Please include as much information as you have, including full name, hometown, home unit, rank, age, date of birth/date of death, and any photos of the individual you may have. Supporting documentation is desired. This can be anything from reports to news articles.
